Grocery stores, a bakery cafe, liquor store, bank, pharmacy, vehicle repair shops, and several other small businesses offer friendly small town service in a lovely rural setting. In the summer months, take the time to enjoy the local produce at the Farmers Market and visit the park and picnic areas. Fishing in Ontario - Licensing Fees

100% of your fishing license fees go towards protecting the future of fish and wildlife in Ontario. Here is the breakdown:

- 22% Regulation -15 fishery zones supporting Ontario fisheries in managing fish limits, specie seasons etc
- 19% Science Surveys at 762 lakes over the last 5 years to better understand the health of our lakes and fishery resources
- 18% Enforcement conservation officers on land and water
- 17% Licensing administration, office supplies, issuer fees
- 16% Conservation stocking lakes and continuing fish hatcheries
- 8% Education the learn to fish program had 7,900 individuals participate in 2018

Lucky Strike, an Ontario fishing manufacturer for 90 years, is recommending the best lures for Charleston Lake's game fish. Smallmouth Bass recommended lures are crankbait, worm harness and spinnerbaits. Check our their Yellow Perch Live series. For Lake Trout; a prized catch, try trolling spoons in a wide range of colours. The "Johnny Green" is our favourite. Northern Pike prefer trolling spoons and plugs of red and white colour combinations. The half wave spoon is a prize winner! Largemouth Bass are known to prefer soft plastic worms and frogs, surface baits, crank baits and jigs. The sunfish Live Series has been nailing them! Lucky Strike provides Ontario's anglers with a wide variety of equipment to land their catch safely and quickly. New designs incorporating flat bottom landing net bags with rubberized mesh, cradle the fish, presenting it to the angler for easy handling. Happy fishing, and good luck!
