House Rules

Bonfire Pit: Wood and newspaper only please. Our lovely bonfire pit will warp if other materials are used.

Gas Cans: Please do not use gas cans to fill your boat at our docks. There is a large risk of gas ending up in the lake which leads to environmental hazards to our beautiful lake - if you need fuel, we would be happy to assist you at our gas docks.

BarBQs: Please clean off the BarBQs if you use them so they are ready for the next renter. If the bbq requires cleaning after your departure, there will be a \$60 fee.

Bedding: Please bring your own bedding. If bedding is required there will be an added \$40 fee.
